The term Computer-Aided Design (CAD) was first coined in 1959 by the British engineer Michael R. Cowell at Bletchley Park in the UK. Cowell was one of the co-developers of the Z3, the world's first fully programmable computer. When he first used the term CAD, it was meant to describe programs that assisted the user in the design of mechanical, electrical, and architectural products. The term was later adopted by the mechanical CAD industry. Today's variants of CAD include Computer-Aided Design (CAD) and Computer-Aided Engineering (CAE). In AutoCAD, a number of measurements are used that are not the traditional units of measurement. With help from a \$5.4 billion investment from Autodesk, Inc. in April 2012, Align Technology, Inc. of San Jose, California began development on AutoLISP, a derivative of AutoCAD's native programming language. This has been billed as the "most modern Lisp ever." After it was launched as a beta release, Autodesk renamed it AutoLISP in March 2013. AutoCAD is installed on 80% of the CAD workstations in the world. In 2013, Autodesk AutoCAD released the 2012 version of AutoCAD. As AutoCAD 2015, the new release of AutoCAD, introduced a number of changes to the user interface. These include the new ribbon-style interface. The ribbon is a single window which automatically resizes based on the size of the document being opened. The ribbon also has four "pages" (or tabs) available in the application. Another change to AutoCAD introduced in 2012 was the implementation of 3D. AutoCAD 2011 was the first version of AutoCAD to feature 3D, which is seen as the natural progression of the software. Other changes include the addition of "sphere" tools. In addition to the 3D tools, Autodesk also announced that AutoCAD would now be available for iOS devices. In late 2018, the Windows, Linux, macOS, and iPad versions of AutoCAD were updated with a new user interface, 3D functionality, the ability to create GIS (geospatial) plans, and several new features.
